### **Publisher/President** – Envision Journalism, Eugene, Oregon (2013 – present)

- Lead publication alongside the Editor-in-Chief, and was charged with managing the financial, ad, marketing and PR efforts of Envision
- Transformed publication from web-only to offering tablet and print editions
- Founded Envision Media, an umbrella 501(c)(3) non-profit organization for Envision Journalism
- Dramatically expanded the publication's network of financial supporters and secured \$10,500 in grants
